Write Your Own (WYO) Bulletin Issued August 9th re: Elevation & Dry Floodproofing Certificates

On July 7, 2023, FEMA announced the approval of the Elevation Certificate and Dry Floodproofing Certificate (refer to WYO bulletin W-23006). The new expiration date of these forms is 06/30/2026. The revised forms (found here on FEMA's Underwriting web page) should be used, going forward.

FEMA has received inquiries requesting the usage of the expired forms. Please refer to the guidance found here in the August 9 WYO bulletin.

- > For NFIP insurance rating purposes, FEMA will accept a properly completed prior Elevation or Dry Floodproofing Certificate signed or certified prior to November 1, 2023.
- > For NFIP communities participating in the Community Rating System (CRS) Program, FEMA will accept a properly completed prior Elevation or Dry Floodproofing Certificate signed or certified prior to November 1, 2023.
- > In NFIP non-CRS communities, for floodplain management compliance purposes, communities can use their discretion for certifying elevation information.
